I hope you are making plans to attend the 2018 California Rangeland Conservation Coalition Summit in Stockton, CA on Tuesday, January 16. The Summit theme is, *Wildlife Policies – Impacts to Rangeland Conservation & the Role for CRCC*. If you are, we would like to invite you to consider bringing a poster describing some of your rangeland conservation and research efforts. The goal of the poster session is to stimulate conversation about conservation efforts, land management issues and practices, and scientific investigations about these ecosystems.

Information and Guidelines

- When & Where: Posters will be displayed Tuesday, January 16. You can arrive to set up posters from 7:30 to 8:30 am. Poster presentations and discussions will take place during the several break sessions and lunch scheduled during the day. Remove them when you leave.
- Poster content: Anything related to rangeland conservation – from descriptions of resources that land managers may find useful to examples of projects and activities, research activities, outreach or education programs, or other things you think might be useful to share with the ranching and rangeland conservation community. Please gear presentations towards the interests of conservation practitioners, ranchers, and project management staff. E
- Posters should not exceed 48" x 48". If you have something you would like to display that would require a larger space, please contact the poster session chair (below).
- Deadline: Please complete and send the form on the next page to the poster session chair by Friday, December 22 to receive full consideration and to have the abstract included in the program, with later submissions accepted until January 10 on a space-available basis. Poster display space will be allocated in the order that poster request forms are received. Space is limited, so please register early!
- Supplies: Posters will be hung on metal or fabric walls. Mounted posters and your own floor easel is recommended. More information on hanging requirements will be available at a later date.
- Don't forget to register online for the Summit: registration information will be available in the coming weeks (and if you submit an abstract, I will remind you to register).
